(a) "That portion of location 537 marked on the attached plan resumed for recreation purposes as a playing ground

(B) "That part of Reserve No. 9299 owned by the Education Endowment Trustees marked on the plan west of the Govt Blocks, through the Sanitary Depots to the Beach declared a Reserve and handed over to the Board as a natural garden & lookout for the people

(C) That part of Reserve 5827 - lot 157 lying north of the alignment of the R.O.W. between Cross & Reeve Sts be also handed over to the Bd as a permanent reserve

CS. B. & C. to form one integral playing ground & Lookout for the people for all time

In lieu of the above & to compensate the Govt. for any financial loss the Bd request
